Myers Memorial continues to have a strong Christian Education program which affords its members the opportunity to follow Jesus and make disciples. A majority of our active members take part in Sunday school and/or small group opportunities. We currently offer

Disciple 1, 2 and 4 for folks who desire deeper study. We also offer Divorce Care, Divorce Care for Kids, and Grief Share for our members and our community. These support/study groups help to meet unique needs that folks experience in their faith journey.

In our efforts to transform the world, we are trying to find ways to engage our community. We are seeking to find ways to invite our community to visit our space and engage with our members. This year we have hosted:

- Super Sunday (the Gastonia K-9 unit and Fire Department visited as our hometown heroes)
- *Pumpkin Palooza* (after all we are "the pumpkin church")
- Vacation Bible School which saw a record 133 in attendance (many were from our community)
- Facebook Live Worship (homebound, those out of town, and the unchurched can worship with us)

Myers Memorial is home to Meals on Wheels, NA, Alanon, Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts. We are trying to find ways to make sure our community partners feel welcomed in our space and share joint ministry with us. Our witness committee recently delivered nearly 60 pumpkins to area businesses to let them know we are glad to be their neighbor. We hope to find more ways to connect with area businesses.

During this last year, we have seen multiple staff transitions. Our Staff Parish committee has worked diligently to write job descriptions and hire staff based on our current needs and dreams for the future. We thought outside of the box and hired a clergy person to serve as our Director of Communication and Evangelism. We took a leap of faith to expand our successful music program by hiring a full time Director of Music. These additions to our program staff build upon the excellence in programing that Myers expects and together with our

Director of Christian Education and Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministry position us to grow and expand in the years ahead. Because of these staff additions, I celebrate that we now host a current and relevant website being maintained in house and we offer

amazing worship arts opportunities for children and youth. We have also added another opportunity for worship with our Wednesday Connect service at 6:15p on Wednesdays. We have averaged over 60 in attendance in the short time we have been gathering.

For nearly 30 years, Myers has housed a child care ministry in our church. It began as a mother's morning out program and over the years has transformed into a weekday preschool. We began this school year with a

new director, and I believe that we have the opportunity to allow this ministry to help our church grow in vitality. Our director is bilingual which provides the opportunity for children to be exposed to another language and for our program to reach new families in the community. We currently have 8 teachers and 37 students who bring life to our building five days a week. In addition to a preschool curriculum, our students are offered Spanish, chapel and music each week. Our new church administrative assistant partners with the preschool to ensure timely tuition payments. Her experience and organization are essential to the ministry of the church and preschool. Additionally, our building superintendent ensured the preschool wing received much needed updates to the restrooms, so that our space was ready to welcome new students and families.

Our 2017 ministry theme is hospitality. I began the year preaching a sermon series on hospitality and at our leadership summit each committee made at least one hospitality related goal for 2017. We must continue to be a place where ALL God's children feel welcomed and included. As we look towards a new year, we must strive to be invitational by knowing, engaging, and inviting our neighbors to partner with us.

I am grateful and humbled to be the pastor at Myers Memorial UMC in Gastonia.

Worshipping with Children: Tips for the Congregation & Parents

At Myers, children are valued and nurture. We are committed to helping them learn how to worship. We want children to understand that this is a place where they loved, welcomed and accepted.

Tips for the Congregation:

- Greet the children, not just their parents, who are around you before and after worship, and during the passing of the peace. Make them feel like an important part of the worship service.
- Put the offering plate in children's hands instead of passing it over their heads.
- Sit next to a child in worship. Point to words in the hymnal or bulletin.

Tips for the Parents:

- Encourage children to participate in offering by sharing their financial resources.
- Allow them to fill out a Connection Card. Even if it's just their name, it's a way they can offer their selves to God.
- All children are invited forward to communion. This can be a meaningful part of service for both of you.
- Talk about worship at home during the week. (That's like what Pastor Sally said during the sermon" or "Do you remember the story we heard in church?") This reinforces what they've learned.

Spotlight on a Hymn For All the Saints (UMH#711) was written by William W. How, a bishop of the Anglican Church, and first published in Horatio Nelson's Hymns for Saints' Days in 1864. The text is paired with SINE NOMINE, written for this text in 1906 by Ralph Vaughan Williams, the wellknown English composer The title SINE NOMINE means "without a name" in Latin; it may refer to the many saints whose names are known only to God. This hymn is traditionally sung for All Saints' Day, for funerals, or for services on the theme of the Church triumphant. The stanzas of the hymn "For All the Saints" describe the common life of all the saints: the credit due to Jesus Christ for drawing us all to Him, the strength and guidance we continue to draw from Him, our joint communion in Christ, the continuing struggle against evil, and the coming day when the dead shall rise and we shall all worship together before God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This will be our Opening Hymn on All Saints Day, so check it out before we worship on November 5th.


