Bright News Regarding the Sanctuary Lighting Campaign

As of April 22, we have received \$15,191 designated funds for the Sanctuary Lighting Project of replacing the main Sanctuary lights (without the diming capacity). There is still a higher goal to purchase and install a dimmer panel as well as replace specialty lights in the Sanctuary. As well as the replacements and modifications needed in the Narthex, educational wing, administrative offices and Christian Fellowship Center with a complete total of \$60,000. We are grateful for the giving already received and we have confidence we will be able to fully fund this, make the necessary improvements and ultimately receive a rebate from our power service provider. With all this, we will also know we are being good stewards of our resources. Thank you for your contributions! 


Greated by God



Pet Health

Most pet owners don't realize their furry friends can become diabetic. The symptoms in animals are much the same as diabetes in humans.

- 1. Excessive eating
- 2. Excessive drinking and urination
- 3. Weight Loss

These changes can occur quickly and if left untreated, serious consequences such as cataracts and severe changes in the way their body functions can occur. Typically insulin is required to control diabetes in your pet. The amount of insulin required to regulate blood glucose varies greatly from dog to dog. Cats are typically more difficult to regulate than dogs. So if your pet (dog or cat) is showing symptoms they should be seen by your veterinarian.
