- Don't forget Youth Sunday School classes. Classes begin at 9:45. Middle Highs (7 & 8 grades) and Senior Highs (9-12 grades)
- “Soulfire” is our youth choir that meets during the school year (Sept.-May) in the Chancel Choir room from 9:15-9:45 am with Ellen Brown our Music Director and Susan King.
- Our Youth Lounge is for you to have a safe place to fellowship, pray, relax and enjoy. PLEASE leave things in order when you leave.
