Mid Year Finance Update

Myers Finance Committee would like to share our financial information through June, 2019.

We have collected \$312,711.98 through June. Our budgeted collections through June would have been \$344,881.53 so we collected \$32,169.55 less than our projected cumulative budgeted collections through June. We collected 89.45% of what we expected.

We spent \$308,481.07 through June which was \$36,400.48 less than what we budgeted!

Overall, we are \$4,239.17 under budget so we are in the GREEN! Thanks again to our staff for being good stewards of our offerings.

Backpack Weekend Food Program

These were a few of the comments the Backpack Weekend Food Program received from Sherwood Elementary where Myers Memorial UMC provides up to 25 protein rich food sacks each week to children identified as lacking a consistent food source over the weekend. This ministry at Myers is spearheaded by the Wednesday Morning Women's Bible Study. The cost for this ministry is roughly \$7,500 to \$8,000 each school year. All are invited to contribute financially, pack meals on a monthly basis or assist in the delivery of the meals each week. Thank you for caring for the youngest among us!

- ⇒ Students are able to maintain healthy caloric intake over the weekend. Also, these students form a connection with the coordinator and sometimes additional needs are fulfilled.
- ⇒ The program is a great asset to our students. My students who qualify for this program ask frequently when they will get their backpacks restocked on their restock days. They depend on this program.
- ⇒ I am grateful for this program. It is vital to learning that students are not hungry. It is beneficial and I hope it will continue to be funded.
- \Rightarrow Provides needed resources that otherwise they wouldn't have.
