from the Health Cabinet

One of the big issues in the opioid epidemic is diversion, or the pilfering of prescribed pain killers from home medicine cabinets...that people illegally give or sell to others. Often, this is done by youth in the home, their friends, and by tradespeople working in homes. We've even heard that people tour homes for sale, to steal drugs. Many of us save opioids thinking one day we'll need them to relieve unexpected pain. And, all too often, we forget we have them.

We ask you to gather your out-of-date and no-longer-needed medications — opioids and other medications... pills, fluids, and ointments — and bring them to the CFC on Wednesday, October 9, between 11:30a and 1p, or to the Pumpkin Patch on Sunday, October 13 between 12p and 1:30p where a police officer will collect and safely discard them following Drug Enforcement Agency rules.

This will reduce the risk of opioid misuse and, by not flushing these medications, will help protect our waterways.

Items Accepted Prescription medications, All over-the-counter medications, Pet medications, Vitamins & supplements, Medicated ointments, Iotions, creams & oils, Liquid medication in leak-proof containers, Homeopathic remedies, suppositories

Items NOT Accepted Thermometers, needles and syringes, Bloody or infectious waste and IV bags, Personal care products, Hydrogen peroxide, Aerosol cans, Full Inhalers, Chemotherapy pills—please return them to the provider who prescribed them for you.

from the Finance Committee

Greetings! We have already been discussing the 2020 budget and we meet next on October 1 to begin our work. Here are some financial details for the year as of the end of August, 2019.

Pledged collections received as of 8/31/2019, are \$311,089 which represents 100.39% of the expected budget amount January through August. We can all celebrate that. Our Unpledged collections as of 8/31/2019 are \$79,502 which represents 53.93% of the expected budget amount January through August. Overall collections (including miscellaneous other collections) are \$61,389 less than expected using an even 12 month year. As we know, collections do not come in evenly each month.

We also celebrate that we have paid apportionments through August of \$18,670 which is 49.6% of the expected apportionment budgeted payments to date. Another win is that our spending is less than expected so far this year. We have spent \$459,842 through August which is 91.94% of expected spending.

Our net (all collections less spending) year to date finds us in the red by \$24,304. We have the summer vacations behind us now though. Thanks to each of you for your awesome support of our church. And thank you to the staff for their stewardship with our funds.
