Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent, a time when many Christians prepare for Easter by observing a period of fasting, repentance, moderation and spiritual discipline. You are invited to cultivate the Fruit of the Spirit as found in Galatians 5:22-23. The Church will host an Ash Wednesday drive-in service at 12:3pm on February 17th in the church parking lot located behind Bank of America. We will utilize our FM transmitter so you may listen in the comfort of your vehicle. We will also make available the Sanctuary for prayer and reflection at 2p and 4p. That evening a service will premier at 6p on Facebook and YouTube. Please make the time on Ash Wednesday to recall God's words to Adam in Genesis 3:19 "remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return".

Reverse Chili Bowl

Our annual Chili Bowl will be a little backwards this year but we'll still be enjoying the festivities and making a contribution to CAM! This year we will be collecting all the makings for a delicious pot of chili and the recipe! The idea is for you to take a favorite (or generic) chili recipe, purchase all the ingredients - down to the spices, hot peppers and cloves of garlic - but don't cook it! Freeze the meats, and bring all the ingredients to church before Super Bowl Sunday (February 7). We'll donate the complete makings for multiple pots of chili to Crisis Assistance Ministry (yes, they welcome fresh vegetables and meats!). We will collect food donations on February 7 at the 11a communion service and a chili pot will be available for any financial contributions to CAM!

Over the last few years it has been my responsibility and honor to send cards to folks who may need some cheer, are sick, have lost someone, need encouragement, deserve a thank you and so many more reasons. Before working here I didn't know how much a card can mean to someone. I personally would just send the card and said a prayer for the person who receives it and move on. Life gets busy and it was hard to have time to stop and send a card. Looking back growing up it was only really at birthdays that we would receive a card in the mail. Not here at Myers Memorial! Cards are an important part and help us stay connected. It helps us remember we are loved by our family here at Myers Memorial UMC.

When Covid hit we had to totally rethink how we do things. So many changes had to be made with the way we worship, fellowship, and how we did our daily job task. One thing did not change though. We were still able to send some love through the mail. We wanted to stay connected. We wanted to remind people they are loved even if we can't see each other right now.

Each week I work hard to reach out to shut-ins in the church, the lost, the lonely, the sick, and even residents in several assisted living centers in our area. I send them notes of love and it includes devotions and activities for them to work on during the week. Some of those cards go as far as Ohio and Winston Salem.



We have been blessed to receive so many calls and cards back expressing how the card ministry has meant so much to them. I've been given many words of appreciation. Some that stood out to me were statements like: "I don't understand how you all can care so much for someone you have never met but that it has meant the world to me and I have felt loved." or "I love the cards each week and that not one is the same, each one being different and unique", "You should write for a card company because you always send the best written cards." "Thank you for the cards, I display them in my room and reread them when I need some encouragement." "Your card this week really touched me, thank you for the kind words." Although these words aren't necessary they remind me of why this ministry is so important and why I take great joy in doing it each week.

There are so many people out there who have no one to check in on them or send them a reminder they aren't alone in this world. Many who are battling silently and are depressed and lonely. What a simply meaningful way to show you care. We should be proud of the card ministry we have here at Myers.

She handles books for multiple clients, including another United Methodist church very similar in membership and budget. She came to us very highly recommended. Her efficiency and ability for cost management savings were noted by her clients.

We are grateful for the years of partnership with Cherry Bekaert. As we transition to Amelia, we will find about a \$10,000 savings to our church budget for bookkeeping services.

Ameila will be in the office on Tuesday afternoons and at other times working remotely very similar to our arrangement with Cherry Bekaert. Angie Rutlege at Cherry Bekaert and Amelia will be working over the next few weeks to create a seamless transition. Amelia will continue to maintain the confidentiality we are accustomed to with our finances and individual contributions. We anticipate this transition to be easy for everyone. There will be no changes to online giving through Vanco services. What will change is the address where you need to send your financial contributions. Additional Small Cage: \$12 each (8" tall, collapsible for storage and holds up to 4 butterflies

These are live animals and we cannot guarantee that each one will become a butterfly. It is advised to purchase more than you may need. Caterpillars will arrive to the church around mid-March. You will be notified when they are ready for pick up and your prompt response to pick up is necessary so that they are in the proper stage for an Easter release (April 4) no matter where you are to celebrate the Risen Savior in 2021.
