## Epiphany 2021

Epiphany is the day Christians remember the coming of the Magi to visit Jesus, bringing their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. The arrival of these visitors was a sign that the incarnation of God in Christ had been made known and was recognized by the heavens to the whole world, so that even Gentile wise men from the East come to pay him homage. It occurs every year on January 6, the 13th day after Christmas. At Myers Memorial we will celebrate Epiphany Sunday on January 3rd. Please join us for Worship at 9am, live on Facebook and YouTube and then drive by the church between 10:15a and 10:45a to pick up Communion elements, your annual scripture verse and chalk to mark your home with an Epiphany blessing.

## Baptism of the Lord Sunday

On Sunday, January 10, we will celebrate Baptism of the Lord Sunday. This is the day in the Christian year we remember and celebrate the Baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. We will also remember our own baptism, that celebration of the love God has for each of us and all humanity. Join us for worship at 9a, live on Facebook and YouTube. Then drive by the church between 10:15a and 10:45a to touch the water and remember your baptism.
