Join us as we follow in Jesus' footsteps through Israel, the Holy Land. Our pilgrimage will visit inspirational sites that bring to life the stories of Jesus and the Bible in the Galilee, Bethlehem, the Dead Sea area and Jerusalem.



While the itinerary is subject to change, and many more details are on the travel website, we will fly from Charlotte to Tel Aviv through Munich then travel for our stay in the Galilee area. We will spend five nights in the Galilee area visiting the sights, enjoying a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee as well as visiting unique local businesses. Then on to Jerusalem for a four night stay visiting the Old City with the Western Wall, Upper Room, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, then the Dead Sea/ Masada area where we can float in the Dead Sea! We'll visit newer parts of Jerusalem and conclude with a tour of Bethlehem.

This pilgrimage will be a wonderful opportunity for us to bond as friends, share in our faith, have lots of fun together and come back with memories to las a lifetime. The price is based on a minimum of 20 participants and will be reduced if we have more than 25 so be sure to invite your family, friends and neighbors!


our friends from Trinity as we can imagine this is an emotional time in the life of their church. We do give God thanks for over 100 years of ministry they have offered in Gaston County.


