SUNDAY WORSHIP & SPECIAL SERVICES

We worship Sundays we worship at 9a and 11a in the Sanctuary and via livestream on Facebook, YouTube and our Church Website. Please make note of the special services as we journey through the Lenten season and into an Easter celebration!

- Wednesday, February 22: Ash Wednesday Service, 6p, Sanctuary. Ash Wednesday emphasizes two themes: our sinfulness before God and our human mortality. During the service we will be marked with the sign of the cross on our foreheads as a sign of mortality and repentance. The ashes come from the previous year's Palm Sunday celebration.
- Sunday, April 2: Palm Sunday, 9a & 11a, Sanctuary. Palm Sunday is a day to highlight Jesus' entry into Jerusalem to shouts of "Hosanna!" and points us towards the days to come as we move through Holy Week, Jesus' last days, his execution, his burial and as we await the resurrection.
- Thursday, April 6: Maundy Thursday Service, Communion and Foot/Handwashing, 6p, Sanctuary. The English word "Maundy" comes from the Latin mandatum, which means "commandment." During the service we will remember Jesus' commandment to love God and love one another through the acts of communion and hand/foot washing.
- Friday, April 7: Good Friday Service of Darkness, 6p, Sanctuary. On Good Friday we proclaim God's purpose of loving and redeeming the world even in the face of human rejection and cruelty through death on the cross. Join us as our music ministry leads us in worship.
- Sunday, April 9: Easter Sunday, 7a Sunrise Service in the Gathering Garden, 9a and 11a in the Sanctuary. You are invited to bring cut flowers to decorate the cross outside the Sanctuary.

FINAL WORDS | LENT 2023

Now that we have read the entire book of the Bible, we're going to take time to look closer at the final words of Jesus spoke as seen and heard through the eyes and ears of those who stood near the cross. In life and in death, Jesus' words were powerful and meaningful. This Lent, we'll encounter first-person stories as might have been told from the viewpoint of one of the characters at the cross. We'll also explore the meaning Jesus' dying words have for us today before recounting the words Jesus' spoke following his resurrection. We hope you will make time for worship each Sunday this Lenten season and/or select one of the small groups using Adam Hamilton's book *Final Words from the Cross*.
