
God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that by always having enough of everything, you may share abundantly in every good work. 2 Corinthians 9:8

In this verse, Paul is offering God's economic plan. God's work is made possible through the generosity of those God blesses. During 2022, I witnessed God's economic plan at work at Myers Memorial UMC. Our congregation was faithful to continue ministry throughout Covid. We did not cancel one single tradition at this church and we found new ways to meet the needs of our neighbors. We were faithful. Our community noticed our faithfulness and wanted to partner with us. We received several financial gifts in addition to your continued financial generosity.



- We received a \$150,000 grant from an anonymous foundation that wanted to help us "spruce-up" our exterior campus. We were able to paint the exterior of the sanctuary, purchase two electronic signs, landscape the bank area outside the sanctuary and do some additional paving of the parking lot.
- We received a \$25,000 grant from the First Gaston Foundation in memory of Jim Windham. This generous gift was completely unexpected. We are most grateful that the First Gaston Foundation wanted to bless our church as they remembered Jim. This gift has not yet been spent and the trustees and finance committees will discern the best way to use this money to remember Jim's faithful service to our church.
- The merger with Trinity UMC brought us additional financial resources as we sold their property. Some of this money has already been used to address current needed capital improvements and additional money has been invested for the future capital needs of Myers Memorial UMC.
- We received a \$75,000 Employee Retention Tax Credit that acknowledged our employees continued work throughout Covid. This money came right at the end of 2022. Between this tax credit and your faithfulness in giving to our budget, we finished 2022 with a large surplus, allowing us to pay our 2023 apportionments in January, thus relieving our 2023 budget of that expense and fulfilling our connectional commitment for the year. Additionally, we placed \$9,500 in a designated account to be used to bless our community through mission work in 2023.

I firmly believe that these gifts were evidence of our faithfulness to God. God provides in abundance. And we are abundantly blessed. That is how God's economy works...always in abundance. The challenge for us is to continue to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to us, so that we can continue to bless others as God has blessed us.

## **ISRAEL: A SUMMER PILGRIMAGE**

Summer 2023 Worship Series
